O'SULLIVAN JOINS UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL AS VICE PRESIDENT OF NURSING

Boston, Mass.--Dorothy A. O'Sullivan was recently appointed vice president of nursing at the University Hospital (UH). In her new role, O'Sullivan is responsible for the overall strategic and operational planning for the Department of Nursing.

Before coming to UH, O'Sullivan served as executive vice president of nursing at the Presbyterian Hospital in New York City. Presbyterian Hospital is a 1,500-bed teaching facility affiliated with Columbia University Medical Center. She also served in various other key administrative nursing roles while working at the Flower and Fifth Avenue Hospital and the Metropolitan Hospital, both in New York City.

O'Sullivan received her bachelor's degree in nursing from Hunter College in New York and her master's in business administration from Wagner College in Staten Island, New York. She is a member of the American Organization of Nurse Executives and the Society of Practitioners, Urologists and Engineers at New York Medical College.
