

NOTES

**David Hoose** joined the Boston University School of Music faculty in 1987 where he is a Professor of Music and Conductor of the Boston University Symphony Orchestra, as well as Chairman of the Conducting Department.

Currently Music Director of The Cantata Singers and Ensemble and of Collage New Music, Mr. Hoose has appeared as guest conductor with the Saint Louis Symphony Orchestra, the Korean Broadcasting Symphony Orchestra (KBS), the Boston Symphony Chamber Players, the Handel and Haydn Society, the Orchestra Regionale Toscana (Italy), and at the Berkshire Music Center. This season he will appear with the Utah Symphony Orchestra. For the last five summers he has conducted the Young Artists' Orchestra of the Boston University Tanglewood Institute.

In 1980, as a conducting fellow at the Tanglewood Music Center, Mr. Hoose received the Dmitri Mitropoulos Award. Also a highly sought-after horn player, he was a member of the Emmanuel Wind Quintet which, in 1981, won the Walter W. Naumburg Award for Chamber Music.
