Open forums on security starting next week; All employees invited to present ideas, concerns.

The UH Management Council next week will begin hearing comments from employees at two open-session forums on ways to improve security in the Hospital. All employees are invited to attend and offer their suggestions and comments.

The forums will be held Monday, March 14, and Wednesday, March 16, at the UH Interfaith Chapel on the first floor of the Preston Building. The Monday session will be held from 10:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and the Wednesday session will be held from 3:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. Members of the Council's working group on security will note all suggestions made and bring them to the attention of the Hospital's senior management. Employees are encouraged to speak out on all safety concerns, even personal ones. The Council will provide feedback on all suggestions.

Because one basic security measure is for all employees to wear their identification badges whenever they are in the Hospital, employees are also invited to share their ideas on ways to encourage this usage. For further protection, the Council's security group is currently working on ways to identify all patient visitors and vendors. Implementation of these plans should markedly reduce the number of unknown people to the Hospital.

Future open-forum sessions are planned in order to hear as many viewpoints as possible. More information on the time and place of these sessions will be forthcoming.
