Broadway Bridge Reconstruction

The reconstruction of the Broadway Bridge, the thoroughfare into South Boston from the corner of Herald and Albany streets, has altered commuter patterns slightly for BUMC employees who utilize the Southeast Expressway. The reconstruction project, which began today, will force commuters to adhere to the following:

Coming southbound into BUMC:

Take Exit 20, the Mass Pike/Albany Street Exit rather than Exit 21, the Albany Street/East Berkeley Street Exit, and proceed onto Albany Street.

Going northbound from BUMC:

Take Albany Street to Frontage Road, the road that is parallel to the Southeast Expressway. At the intersection of Frontage Road and West Broadway, take the ramp to the Southeast Expressway that is directly before you. This is the only access to the Expressway and the Massachusetts Turnpike. There will be no Northbound Expressway access after Broadway from Frontage Road. All northbound traffic on Frontage Road must turn right on Broadway.

Some additional information about the project:

- There will be one lane of traffic maintained in each direction on the Broadway Bridge.
- Southbound traffic on Albany Street will not be allowed to turn left onto Broadway; proceed to the Albany/Berkeley Street turn-around.
- South Boston bound traffic on Herald Street must turn right on to Albany Street and proceed to the Albany/Berkeley Street turn-around.
