NEWTON RESIDENT INSTALLED AS PRESIDENT OF THE AMERICAN COLLEGE OF RHEUMATOLOGY

Boston, Mass.--Robert F. Meenan, M.D., a professor of medicine and director of the Arthritis Section at Boston University School of Medicine (BUSM), was recently installed as the 55th president of the American College of Rheumatology at its 1990 annual meeting in Seattle, Washington.

The College is a 5,000 member organization of physicians and scientists who specialize in the care and study of arthritis and related disorders. Meenan will serve a one year term as president.

Meenan received his bachelor's degree from Harvard College and his medical degree from BUSM. He also holds a master's in public health from the University of California at Berkeley and a master's in business administration from Boston University Graduate School of Management. Meenan is the author of many publications and has been awarded several grants by the National Institutes of Health. He is a Fellow of the American College of Physicians and a member of numerous professional organizations, including the American Society for Clinical Investigation.

Boston University School of Medicine is located in the South End of Boston adjacent to two of its principal teaching hospitals, the University Hospital and Boston City Hospital.
