## **Parking permits to be distributed; applications available at OPTS**

BMC and BU Medical Campus employees who wish to park in campus lots, but have not yet received a parking registration package, should call the BU Medical Center Office of Parking and Transportation Services (OPTS) at 638-4915 and arrange to register for a permit.

Applications are being processed as they are received, so it is important to submit them promptly.

Those without valid permits will be restricted from all BMC and BU Medical Campus parking lots after Monday, Feb. 2.

*The following are the most frequently  
asked parking questions and answers:*

## **What will happen to my application if I did not submit it by the December deadline?**

Applications are still being accepted, but admission to the lots will be restricted to those with valid permits after Monday, Feb. 2.

## **Should I submit a registration package even if I am represented by a union that is negotiating parking rates with BMC?**

Yes. The registration process is in place to ensure that those who are authorized to use BMC parking facilities are able to do so. The registration process is not related to any ongoing negotiations regarding parking.

## **Do employees who are called in on emergencies have to be registered to park in BMC and BU Medical Campus lots?**

Yes. All employees who park on campus must have a valid sticker attached to their vehicles. Any questions concerning parking can be directed to OPTS at 638-4915.
