Boston, Mass. -- William J. Freeman was recently named director of Development for Boston University School of Medicine.

Prior to coming to Boston University, Freeman was development officer for the Boston Ballet where he focused on government grants and corporate giving. He has been a consultant to numerous nonprofit organizations, and has served as a director of the Massachusetts Department of Social Services, Norwood region. In this capacity, Freeman was instrumental in hiring the first regional director and negotiating first-year contracts for this division of the Department of Social Services.

A 1973 graduate of St. John Vianney Seminary, he received an M.A. degree from St. Mary's Seminary and University. He is a member of the Massachusetts chapter of the National Society of Fund Raising Executives.

Freeman lives on Marlborough Street in Boston.

Boston University School of Medicine is the site of several major interdisciplinary research centers, including Hubert H. Humphrey Cancer Research Center and the Cardiovascular Institute of Boston University. The School is an innovator in medical education, offering several alternative curricula leading to the M.D. degree.
