## GERIATRICIANS COMPLETE TRAINING

Three physicians and one dentist recently completed the Geriatric Fellowship Program at the Bedford Veterans Administration Hospital, an affiliate of Boston University School of Medicine. The two-year program is one of 12 nationwide created by the Veterans Administration to train physicians to deliver healthcare to the elderly.
