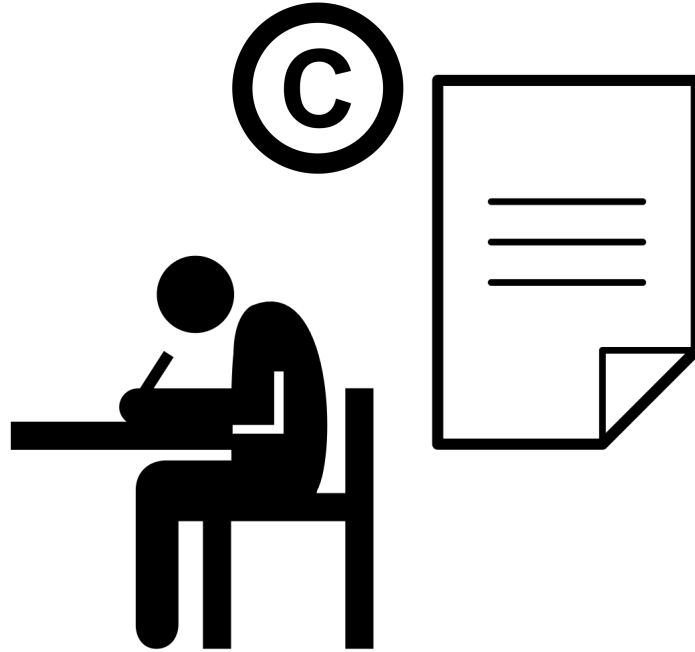

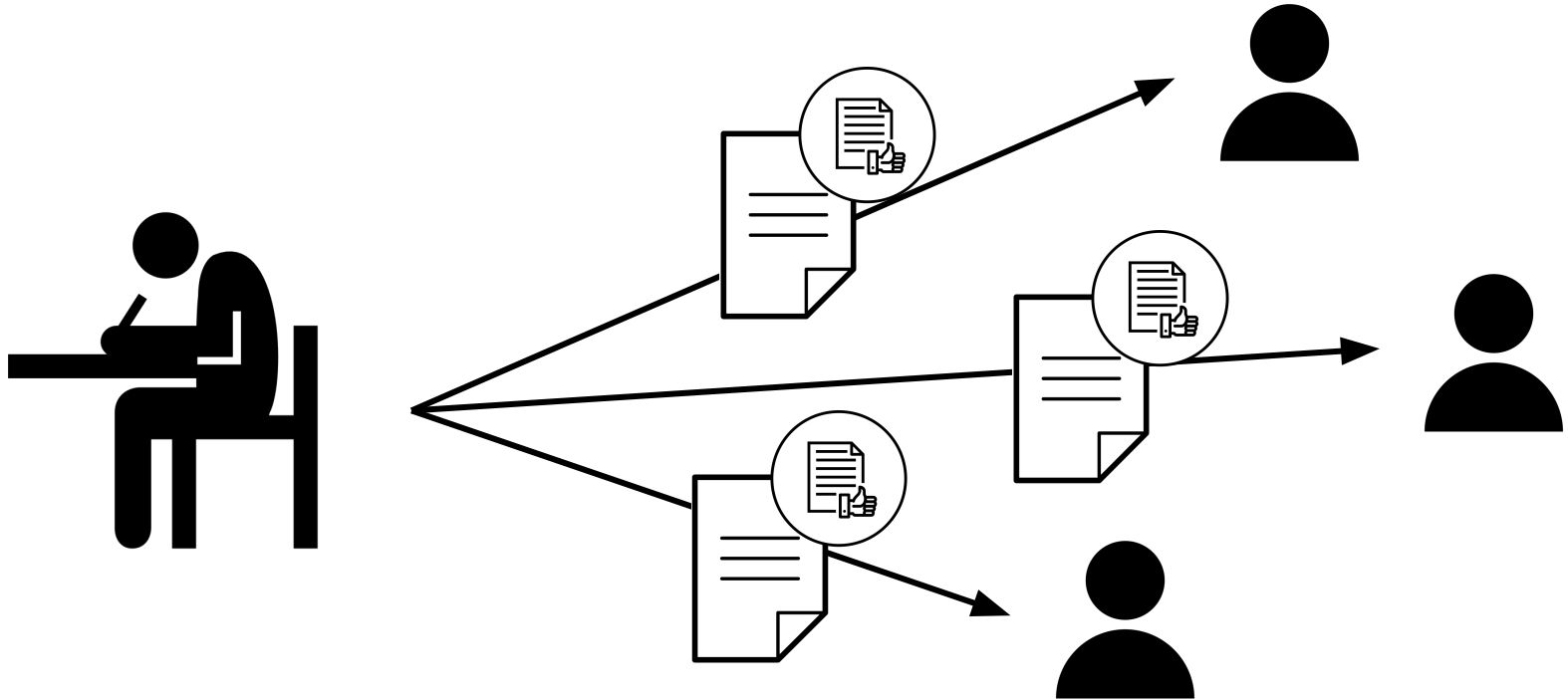
“Each faculty member grants to Boston University **permission** to make available his or her scholarly articles.”

How does this work?

You author a work. You are the copyright holder.

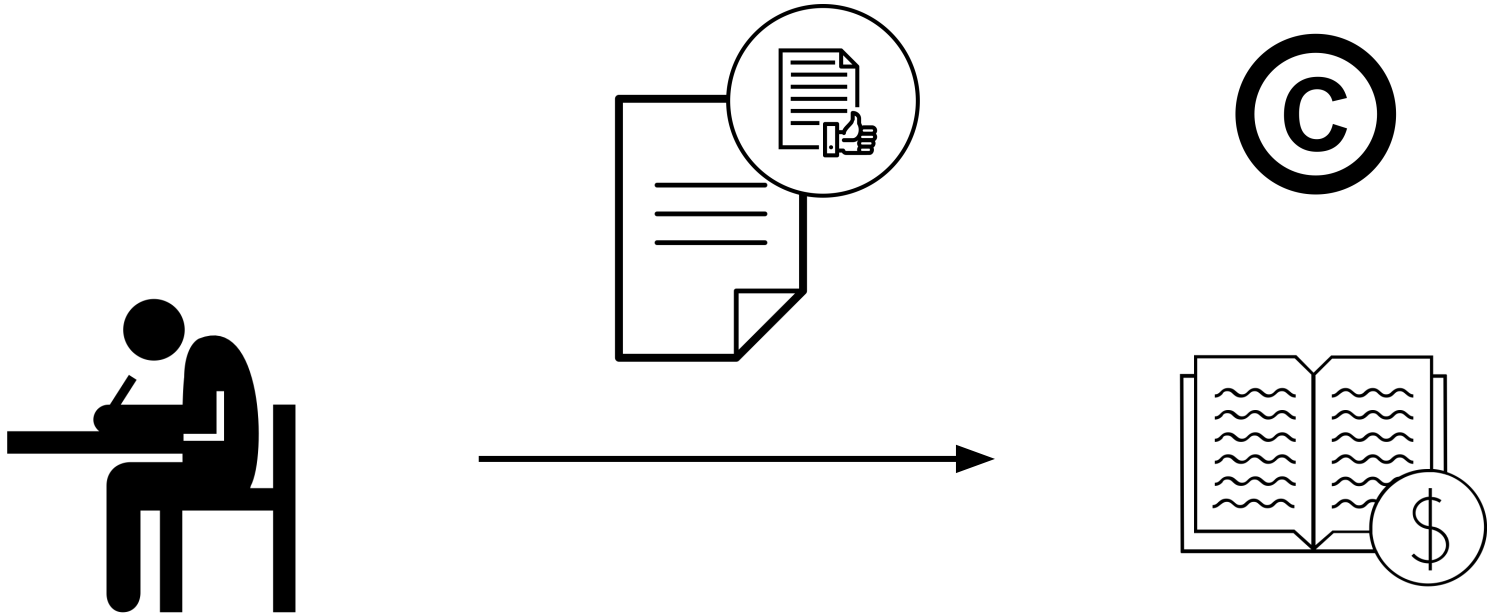


You grant permission to others to use your work by granting licenses.

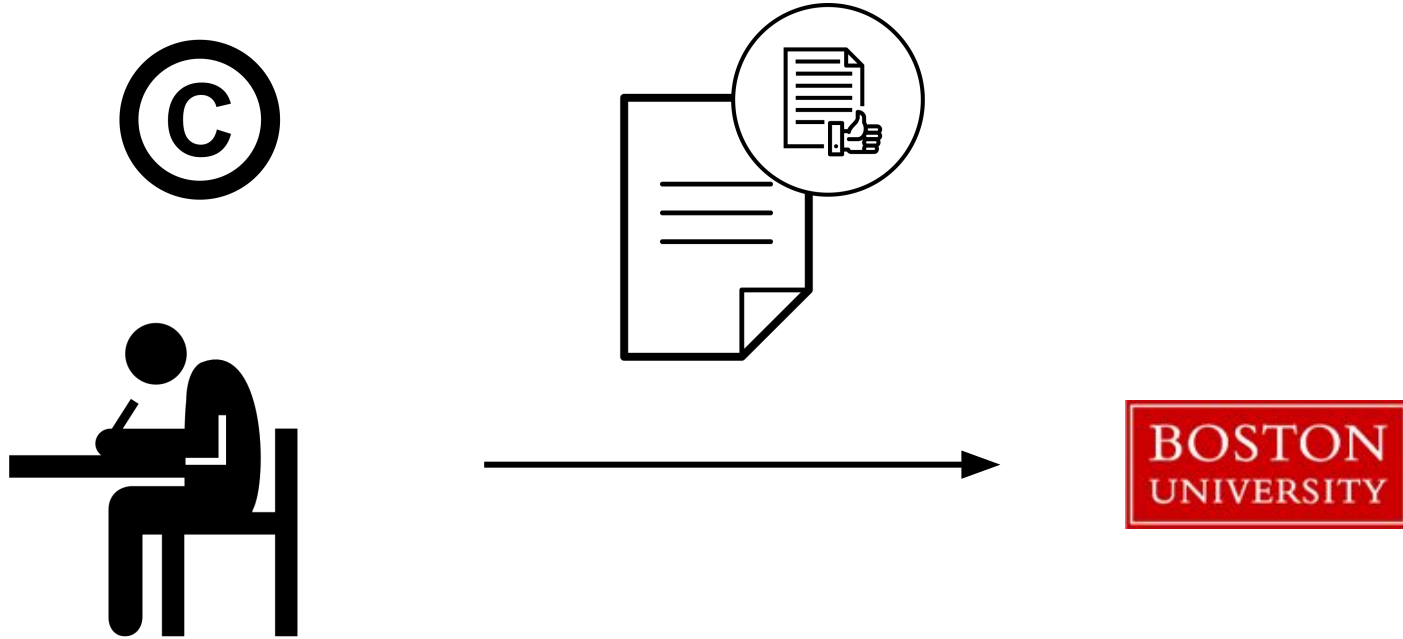


You sign a publishing agreement with a publisher and grant them an exclusive license.

The copyright transfers to the publisher.



**Under the open access policy, you grant
a non-exclusive license to your work to BU.
You retain your copyright.**

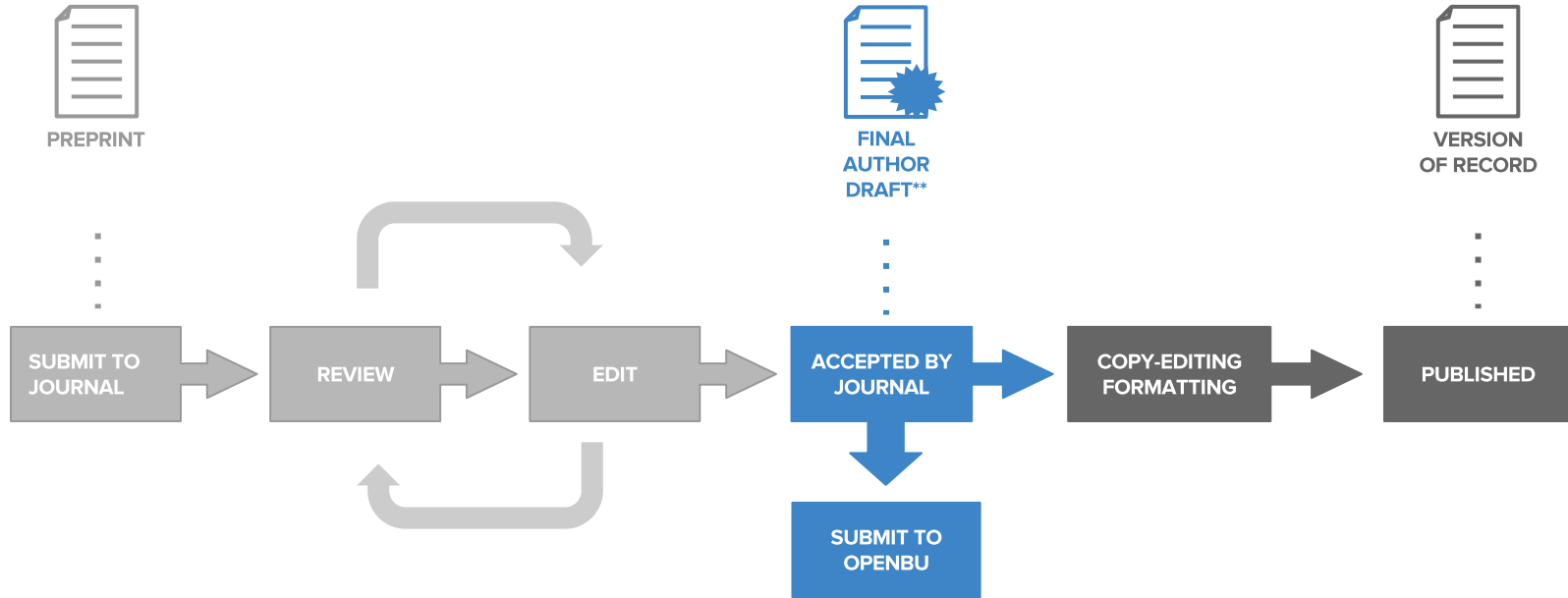
Scholarly Articles

- Writings created “**without payment, for the sake of inquiry and knowledge**”
- Journal articles, conference papers, working papers
- **NOT** book chapters, books, creative works, book reviews, or commissioned works

BU's Opt-out Open Access Policy

“Each Faculty member will provide, at no charge, an electronic copy of the **author's final version** of each article **no later than the date of its publication** to the appropriate representative of the Provost's Office in an appropriate format.”

Final Author Draft (Accepted Manuscript)



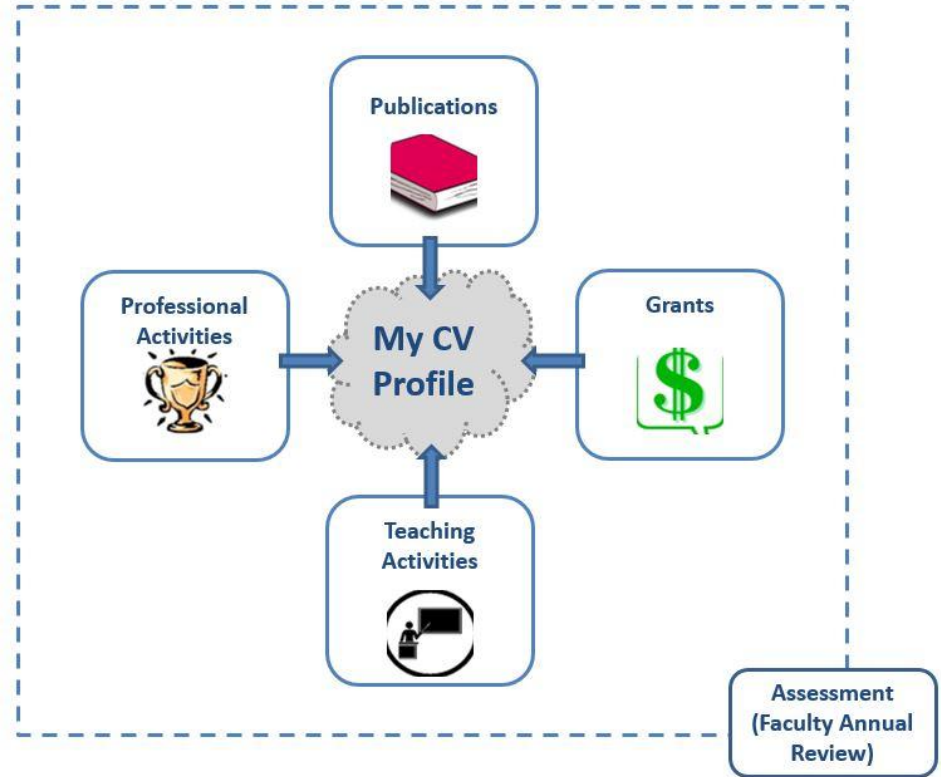

An easy way to submit OA articles



Opting Out

1. Opt out of **immediate open access** by putting an **embargo** on your article.
2. Opt out of **granting BU a nonexclusive license** by requesting a **waiver**.

How does BU's Open Access Policy help you?

- Allows you to make your article openly available without infringing copyright or researching publisher policies
- If you sign away your rights to your article, BU can grant you a non-exclusive license to use your work
