Thomas E. Gaffney, M.D., director of the Department of Pharmacology at the Medical College of South Carolina in Charleston, will deliver the prestigious Creasy Memorial Lecture at the School of Medicine Thursday, April 14, at 4 p.m. in Keefer Auditorium. Title of the lecture is "Hypotheses Related to the Development of New Cardiovascular Drugs."

Gaffney's visit is the result of the School of Medicine's having been awarded a William N. Creasy Visiting Professorship of Clinical Pharmacology for the current academic year by the Burroughs Wellcome Fund. The School is one of only 10 medical schools nationwide to be so honored.

Gaffney, whose visit is being co-sponsored by the departments of Pharmacology and Anesthesiology, will spend the week of April 11-15 at BUSM, teaching medical students, faculty and house staff. The visiting professorship carries an honorarium of \$2,500 plus travel expenses for the professor and accompanying spouse.
