GRIFFITHS APPOINTED ASSOCIATE DIRECTOR OF GYNECOLOGIC ONCOLOGY AT THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL

Boston, Mass.--C. Thomas Griffiths, M.D. of Wellesley Hills, was recently named associate director of gynecologic oncology at the University Hospital (UH). In addition to this staff position, he has also been appointed clinical professor of obstetrics and gynecology at Boston University School of Medicine (BUSM).

Griffiths is internationally recognized for his work on the treatment of ovarian cancer and has lectured extensively throughout the world. The author of numerous publications as well as three books, he also serves as a reviewer for several medical journals.

He received his bachelor's degree from Stanford University and his medical degree from Stanford University School of Medicine. He founded the gynecologic oncology service at the Boston Hospital for Women and subsequently was appointed associate chief of gynecologic oncology at Brigham and Women's Hospital and the Dana Farber Cancer Institute.

The University Hospital, founded in 1855, is a principal teaching hospital of Boston University School of Medicine and a member of Boston University Medical Center.
