BERNARD FOX SPEAKS ON "PSYCHOLOGICAL FACTORS IN CANCER"

(Boston, Mass.)--Malden resident Bernard Fox, Ph.D., a professor of psychiatry at Boston University School of Medicine (BUSM), recently spoke on "Psychological Factors in Cancer." It was the second in a series of lectures sponsored by the Boston Cancer Research Association, a group of clinical and basic researchers from the Boston scientific community.

Fox is a member of the Research Association as well as the American Psychological Association and the Academy of Behavioral Medicine Research.

BUSM is the site of several major interdisciplinary research centers, including the Hubert H. Humphrey Cancer Research Center and the Cardiovascular Institute of Boston University. The School is an innovator in medical education, offering several alternative curricula leading to the M.D. degree. Under the leadership of Dean John I. Sandson, M.D., the School has also established a model low-interest revolving student loan fund to help students finance their medical education.
