NEW TRUSTEE APPOINTED AT THE UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL

Boston, Mass.--Betty Taymor of Eliot Memorial Road, Newton, Mass., was recently appointed by Governor Michael Dukakis to the Board of Trustees of the University Hospital (UH). Taymor is one of five UH trustees appointed by the governor.

Currently, Taymor serves as director of Boston College's "Program for Women in Political and Government Careers." This highly successful graduate program--now in its eighteenth year--has prepared many women for responsible positions in the public sector. As director, Taymor has obtained and administered federal funds to establish a similar program at the state universities in the five other New England states.

Previously Taymor was an instructor at Boston University's Metropolitan College and Northeastern University where she taught courses in American Politics, American Government and Urban Problems. As a consultant to the Office of the President at the University of Massachusetts, Taymor researched and evaluated the status of continuing education in the Massachusetts state college system.

Taymor belongs to many professional and political organizations. She is the founding member of the Massachusetts Coalition for Women's Appointments, the Boston Network for Women in Politics and Government, and the Massachusetts Women's Political Caucus. She also holds appointments with the New England Board of Higher Education and the John F. Kennedy Library Academic Advisory Committee.
